Erratum: A General Law of Functionality: VanCampen's Law

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In the original article [1], the author made a typo error in the equation (8), on page 52. Instead of the presented:

$$(m + i) \leq r \rightarrow J < 0 \quad (1)$$

which means that the probability of Negentropy would be less than 0 (< 0), the correct equation is:

$$(m + i) \leq r \rightarrow J > 0 \quad (2)$$

demonstrating that in fact the probability of Negentropy is greater than 0 (> 0).

Therefore when a comparison would be performed using the correct value (> 0), the J , which is Negentropy, increases, rather than decreases when the incorrect (< 0) would be used. In the original article, this aspect is clearly articulated in the text. The error does not change anything in the rationale of the article, and its main conclusions.
